Section 1. Pursuant to a request made by resolution of the Board of Trustees of the North Bellmore Public Library (the "Library") adopted on February 26, 2015, a Library Bond Proposition in substantially the form as hereinafter set forth shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the North Bellmore Union Free School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District") at the Annual District Meeting and Election to be held on May 19, 2015. Said Library Bond Proposition shall appear in the Notice of Annual District Meeting and Election to be held May 19, 2015, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to include such Library Bond Proposition in said Notice by inserting therein substantially the following paragraphs:

"NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a Library Bond Proposition in substantially the following form shall be presented to the qualified voters of the District at such Annual District Meeting and Election:

LIBRARY BOND PROPOSITION

RESOLVED:

(a) That the Board of Education of the North Bellmore Union Free School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District"), hereby authorizes the construction of an approximately 4,000 square foot addition to, and the partial reconstruction and interior reconfiguration of, the North Bellmore Public Library, located at 1551 Newbridge Road, in the District, the foregoing to include the original equipment, machinery, furnishings, apparatus, and all ancillary and related site and other work required in connection therewith; and the expenditure therefor, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof, of not to exceed the estimated total cost of \$8,900,000;

- (b) that a tax is hereby voted in the aggregate amount of not to exceed \$8,900,000 to finance said estimated total cost, such tax to be levied by and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by said Board of Education; and
- (c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$8.900,000, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable.

Such Library Project Bond Proposition shall appear on the ballot label to be inserted in the voting machines used for voting at said Annual District Meeting and Election in substantially the following condensed form:

RESOLVED:

(a) That the Board of Education of the North Bellmore Union Free School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District"), hereby authorizes the construction of an approximately 4,000 square foot addition to, and the partial reconstruction and interior reconfiguration of, the North Bellmore Public Library, located at 1551 Newbridge Road, in the District, and the expenditure therefor of not to exceed \$8,900,000; (b) that a tax is hereby voted in the aggregate amount of not to exceed \$8,900,000 to finance said cost, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by said Board of Education; and (c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$8,900,000 and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable."
